## Toffee Slim Folio for Apple iPad

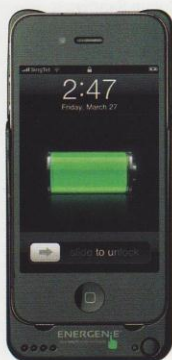
